

## SCARE-A-CON Vendor Terms & Conditions

As a contracted vendor participating in SCARE-A-CON, you are bound and obligated to the following rules and restrictions.

1. Vendor booth reservations are non-refundable. Significant investment is made at the time of reservations and payments are non-refundable.
2. Vendor tables must be manned during all hours the show floor is open. SCARE-A-CON/JOHAW PRODUCTIONS, LLC is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property.
3. All vendor tables/exhibits must remain intact throughout the entire show – from the opening on the first day, until the show closes at the end of the closing day.
4. Vendor table positioning will be determined by SCARE-A-CON/JOHAW PRODUCTIONS, LLC. Space will be assigned upon request but is limited and will be on a 1st come, 1st served basis.
5. Vendors may not occupy aisle space. Aisle spaces need to remain clear in accordance with fire codes.
6. SCARE-A-CON/JOHAW PRODUCTIONS, LLC will not provide insurance coverage for vendors' persons or property. Such insurance is the responsibility of the vendor.
7. SCARE-A-CON/JOHAW PRODUCTIONS, LLC does not warrant or endorse and vendor, its products or its services.
8. SCARE-A-CON/JOHAW PRODUCTIONS, LLC reserves the right to remove any display that can be considered pornographic, bootlegged, and/or drug-related. This type of merchandise or display will be removed immediately at the discretion of the SCARE-A-CON/JOHAW PRODUCTIONS, LLC operations management.
9. Vendors are given admission badges according to the vendor package they buy. Additional badges are offered at a discounted rate of \$30 each, and must be purchased in advance.
10. Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting Sales Tax. PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL STATEMENT FROM TURNING STONE CASINO:

**IMPORTANT TAX INFO: Pursuant to an agreement between the Oneida Indian Nation and the State of New York, vendors that sell goods or services at SCARE-A-CON must be authorized by the Oneida Indian Nation Department of Taxation to collect and remit, and must collect and remit, Oneida Indian Nation sales tax on such sales in accordance with the rules of the Oneida Indian Nation Department of Taxation. To obtain the necessary authorization, vendors must file an application for a Certificate of Authority from the Oneida Indian Nation Department of Taxation at least five (5) days prior to the event. As a result of this agreement, vendors who sell goods or services on Oneida Indian Nation lands are not required to collect or remit sales or use taxes to the State of New York.
